North Carolina Industrial Commission (NCIC) EDI Claims Announcement

NCIC FROI/SROI R3 Event Threshold Change for EMPLOYER'S REQUIREMENT TO FILE A FORM 19 FIRST REPORT OF INJURY!

Date: 01/14/2021

Effective December 1, 2020, the NCIC adopted a change to Rule 11 NCAC 23A .0104(a) for EMPLOYER'S REQUIREMENT TO FILE A FORM 19 FIRST REPORT OF INJURY.

This change increased to four thousand dollars (\$4,000) the medical threshold of charges for when an Employer's Report of Employee's Injury or Occupational Disease is required to be filed as noted below.

- (a) The form required to be provided by G.S. 97-92(a) is the Form 19 Employer's Report of Employee's Injury or Occupational Disease to the Industrial Commission. The Form 19 shall be used when the injury causes the employee to be absent from work for more than one day or when the charges for medical compensation exceed **four thousand dollars (\$4,000)**. The Form 19 shall be filed with the Commission in accordance with Rule .0108(d) of this Section.

This change in the medical threshold amount was effective 12-1-2020 and can be implemented. The FROI/SROI Claims EDI R3 Event Table will be amended to reflect this change, as noted below:
